

Laborers' International Union of North America Local 368 donates to Aloha for Japan

On July 27th, JASH President Ed Hawkins accepted a donation from Local 368 of the Laborers' International Union of North America and Hawaii Laborers' Retiree Council for Japan Earthquake relief under Aloha for Japan statewide campaign. Mr. Hawkins was asked to attend the Union's monthly meeting to accept the donation to support the disaster victims in Japan.

Of note, this was a joint donation of \$5,000 from the members of the Union and a matching \$5,000 donation from the Retiree Council. Union retiree Herbert Loo (pictured) originated the motion to have the Retiree Council donate matching funds. In turn, Mr. Hawkins pledged that 100% of their donations would go to assisting the disaster victims in Japan and to provide periodic feedback on how those funds are being spent in support of the victims.
